



SCHOLARSHIP FUND

A St. Patrick School Scholarship Fund, established in 1982, is used to provide financial aid directly to St Patrick School Families. The Scholarship Fund is a dedicated account where donations from those persons wanting to provide St Patrick School Families with financial assistance are pooled. Donations to this Scholarship Fund cannot be designated or earmarked for the benefit of any specific individual or Family; Scholarship awards are based on financial need

School Families must apply for these Scholarships per St. Patrick Catholic School Board Local Policy SP 3070 (Tuition Assistance Requests). Scholarships from the Scholarship Fund are then awarded to Families on the basis of financial need. The School Principal oversees administration of these Scholarship awards.

The Scholarship Fund differs from the Endowment/Development Fund (reference St. Patrick Catholic School Board Local Policy SP 3210) which is used to provide operating income directly to the School.
